The dolls introduced in this book are made of natural materials and wire. They are soft and stable at the same time, they're movable, have a friendly face, harmonic body proportions and are very solid.

The author shows how the puppet kids can be lovingly created to the smallest detail and introduces different models: mother, father, grandparents, several children, a clown, a circus girl, a rider, dolls from foreign cultures ... The instructions are written in such a way that during many steps of work, parents can involve their children, if they are a little older.
