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***Nature Activities for Children* is a four-volume series on the four seasons which offers kindergarten and school teachers and parents a wealth of ideas for nature-based education.**

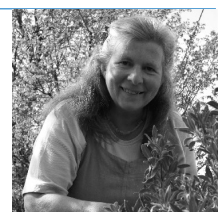
