


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Angelika Wolk-Gerche

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Plants are not only good for dyeing fabrics using many nuances but also for printing them with many forms and colours by applying the techniques of "Ecoprint" and "Bundly Dye." Designer Angelika Wolk-Gerche found rich sources (for inspiration) in her garden, the wayside and the forest, and shows how leaves, blossoms and abstract patterns can be "conjured" onto and into fabrics. From anthracite grey to pale yellow – it's *naturally colourful* everywhere!
